

The Campsite

The campsite is also available for bookings.

It is fully equipped, back to basics site with tents, mess tent, toilet tents and chemical toilets, and cooking utensils.

Toilets are to be emptied into disposal pit in the woods. A small padlock key is provided for access.

There is an altar fire, tap and woodpile.

There is also a smaller site available for patrol or senior section permit camps.

The Chapel and campfire circle are available to users of the site.

The assault course has been refurbished and the climbing tower is available for bookings.

Jubilee House

After many years of fundraising and hard work Girlguiding Oxfordshire has a brand new headquarters and residential centre, this was opened in 2006.

It is available for holidays and overnights by all sections and also for morning, afternoon, evening or full day use.

The maximum number of girls being accommodated in Jubilee House as a residential, sleeping in the main hall is 20, with a recommendation of 18.

Jubilee House has a main hall with a folding partition to allow flexible use of space. This hall may be used for

activities, dining, meetings and sleeping accommodation, (there are 20 camp beds with mattresses with duvet covers which are held in the cupboard to the left as you enter the building). There are lockers for the girls luggage to be stored. A seating area with 3 chair beds has been created for Guiders to relax.

The kitchen is equipped with a refrigerator, freezer, cooker, washing machine, tumble dryer and dishwasher. Crockery, cutlery, pans and utensils are also provided.

There are 3 toilets, 2 showers and 4 hand basins. There is also a separate toilet and shower for guests with disabilities.

The Guiders' room has 2 beds and First Aid room 1 bed and a folding bed.

The house has a specialist, eco friendly sewage system which uses "friendly bacteria" (and electricity) to break down waste.

All cleaning materials will be provided, including hand wash and toilet paper, so users must not use their own or put any waste materials into the toilets or sinks. Cleaning equipment is also provided.

There is access to the outside via doors at the front and rear of the building, including access into a cloakroom area.

The building is well insulated and heated by electrical wall heaters. At present, electricity costs are included in the price, along with the cleaning materials.
